

Excellent times - and wet kit - for Runners

POCKLINGTON Runners made their presence felt at both Holmfirth and Worksop. At Holmfirth two Runners tackled their 15-mile Road Race and it was Mike Siddall who was the first one back in a fantastic time of 1:35:20 to give him 14th position overall, second place in the over-45 age category and first position in the Yorkshire Veterans over-45 age band.

Simon Richardson, the only other Runner there, also did himself proud by recording a time of 1:36:46 to give him first place in the over-50 age category and first position in the Yorkshire Veterans over-50 age band.

Meanwhile, away at Worksop, Pocklington had five runners flying the flag in their half marathon.

Following a tough, hilly and rain-covered course that grew progressively worse throughout the race, it

was Helen Wilcock who was first to appear, crossing the finishing line in a fantastic time of 1:34:44.

Howard Cross was the next Pocklington Runner home and after churning out another fine performance he clocked an impressive time of 1:42:38.

The next two runners for Pocklington kept each other going through some very difficult parts of the race with Sarah Hargreaves finishing in 1:58:38 and Kerry Slater in 1:58:39. In so doing they both came away with a new personal best.

Stephen Fletcher once again travelled to Worksop to tackle this course - this year he had to be content with a time of 2:15:20.

Well done to all of the Pocklington Runners who came away with some excellent times, considering the conditions, trophies and some very wet kit!
